Founded in September of 2008, eFellowship is a social network, similar to Myspace and Facebook, but for members of 12 step programs.

Unlike Myspace and Facebook, eFellowship is only viewable by members.

This allows members to retain their anonymity, while engaging with others in recovery.

The site has discussion groups and the capability to hold audio, chat, and video chat meetings.

Members are also encouraged to post recovery-related events, speaker mp3s, and links.

eFellowship is intended as a sort of 24/7 online meeting and, thus, has no dues or fees. (In other words, it's free).
